600,000 live in the capital

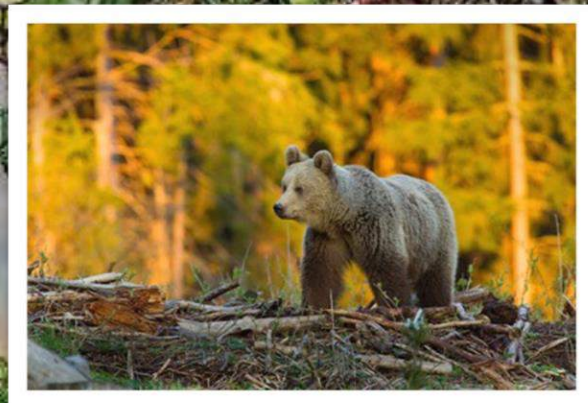

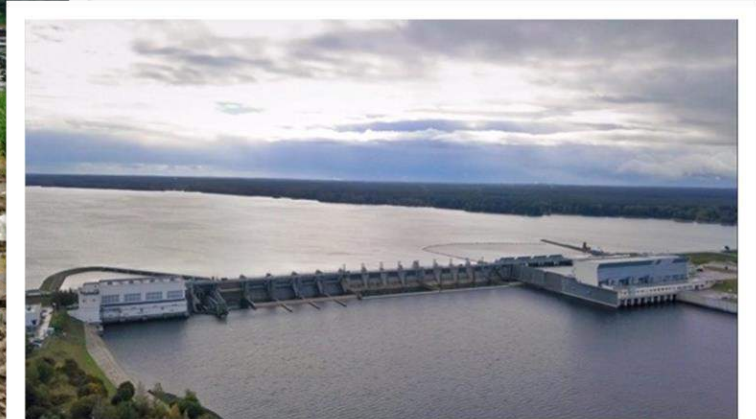
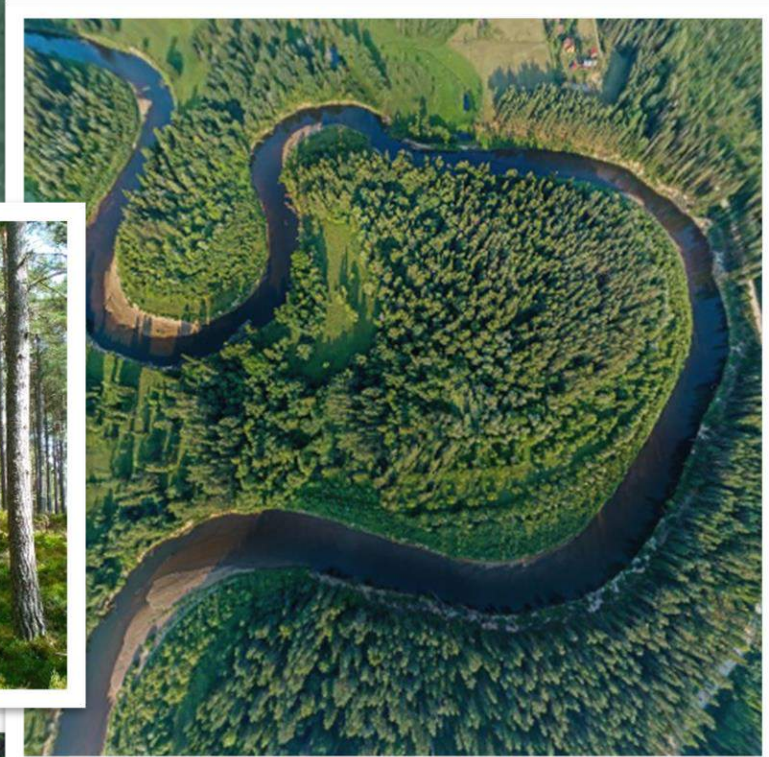
Sustainability of the natural environment

- Diverse ecosystems: forests, meadows, swamps
- Biological diversity
~30,000 species of flora and fauna
- Protected natural territories: nature reserves, biosphere reserves, nature parks, national parks
- Surface waters - rivers and lakes



Latvian forests and rivers

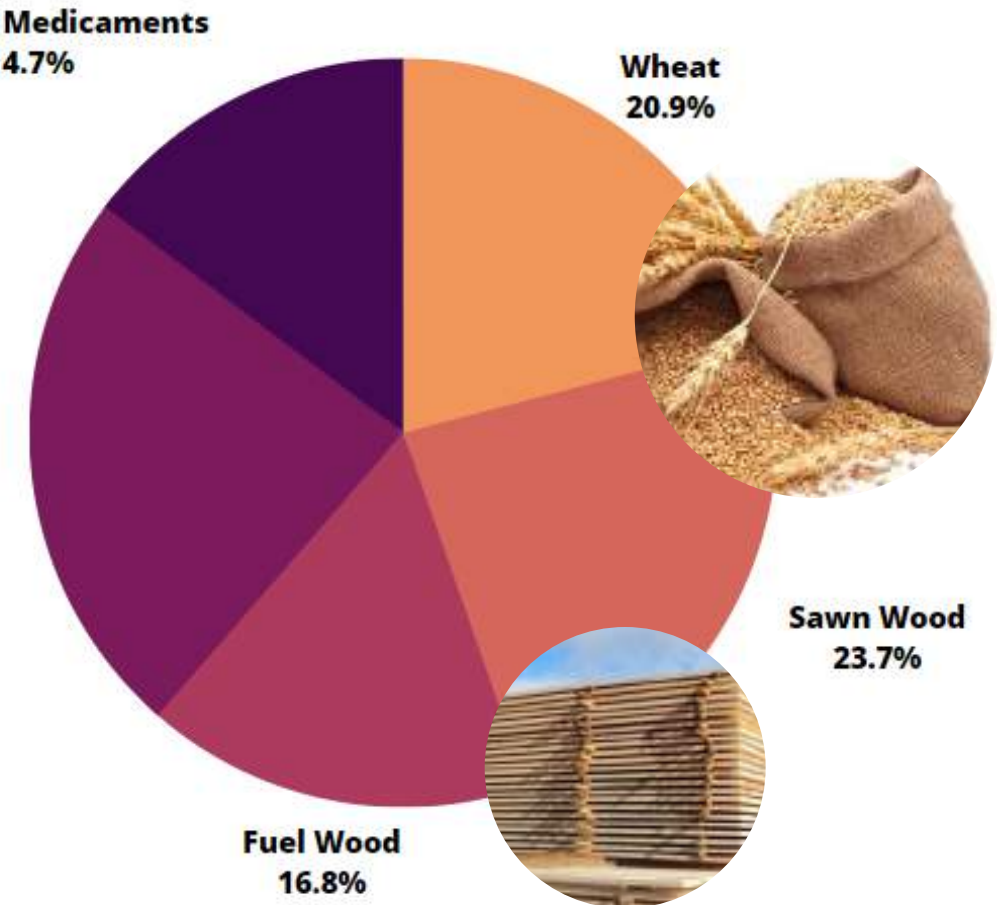
- Latvian National forests are our country's biggest treasure, it covers 3.35 million hectares or 53.8% of Latvia
- There are more than 12,000 rivers in Latvia.
- The longest rivers are Daugava, Lielupe, Gauja and Venta
- Thanks to our rivers Latvia produces 45,1 % of its electricity through hydro power
- Latvia ranks as the third most eco-friendly country in the EU, with an average score of 19.25 out of 28



Economic sustainability

- Latvia's gross domestic product (GDP) in 2021 reached 38,87 billion USD
- Main exports: wood and wood products, charcoal, electronic devices and electric appliances, mineral products, natural honey, etc
- Latvia's main export partners are Lithuania, Estonia, Germany and Sweden
